
#### UTILITY LOCATES

In the event, that a City Utility cannot be located within the specified boundaries of the request area, the contractor/excavator will be notified by e-mail and/or phone of a **mandatory** on-site meeting to discuss alternate measures for protecting the utility. **No** excavation of soil, including boring, is permitted until the on-site meet has taken place and all utilities have been located. Failure to comply will be deemed unreasonable action by the contractor/excavator and may result in the contractor/excavator assuming all liability for damages to such utilities

<b>Red</b>	Electric power lines, cables, conduit, and lighting cables	<b>Blue</b>	Drinking water
<b>Orange</b>	Telecommunication, alarm or signal lines, cables, or conduit	<b>Purple</b>	Reclaimed water, irrigation, and slurry lines
<b>Yellow</b>	Natural gas, oil, steam, petroleum, or other gaseous, or flammable material	<b>Pink</b>	Temporary survey markings, unknown/unidentified facilities
<b>Green</b>	Sewers and drain lines	<b>White</b>	Proposed excavation limits or route
